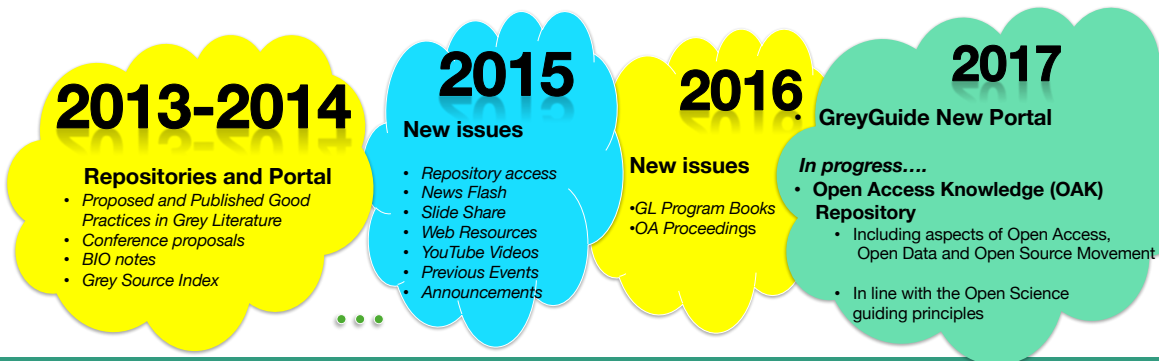
Repository and Guide to Good Practices and Resources in Grey Literature
