Chapter 3: Anthropology/human genetic diversity population reports

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Each participating laboratory has prepared a report describing the origins and historical, ethnographic and demographic information for each population sample, along with relevant results of previous genetic studies and summaries of the IHWG Biostatistic Core's analyses.

These reports are organized by the geographic region in the sections that follow. In some cases, population samples from different regions are described in the same report, and these instances are noted in the table for each region. When there is a discrepancy between the name of the population described in a report and the name used for the population sample in the analyses, the population sample name is provided in parentheses.

The allele, genotype, haplotype data and analyses for each sampled population can be found in appendices C, Tables 1 and 2 respectively, posted at the IHWG website under the Anthropology component (<http://www.ihwg.org/components/diversr.htm>), and in the eBook edition of HLA 2004 to be published by PubMed (<http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/entrez/query.fcgi?db=Books>).
