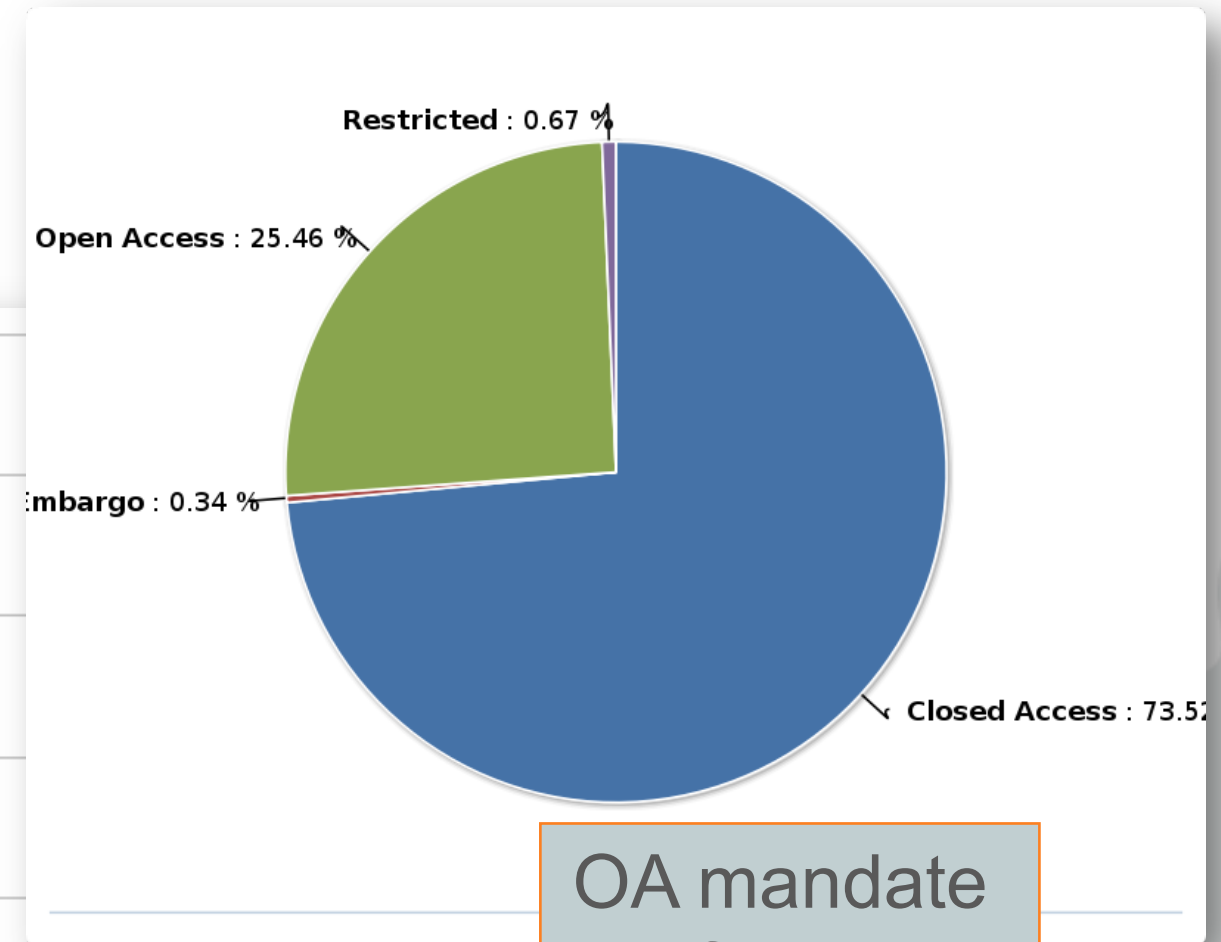

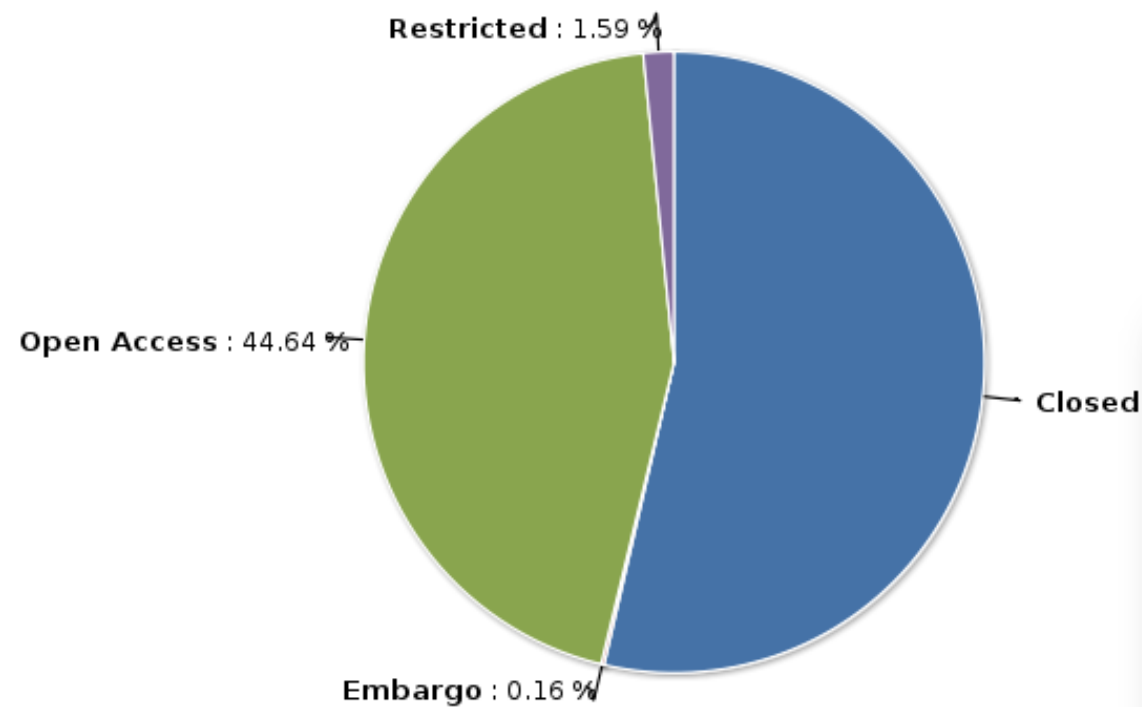

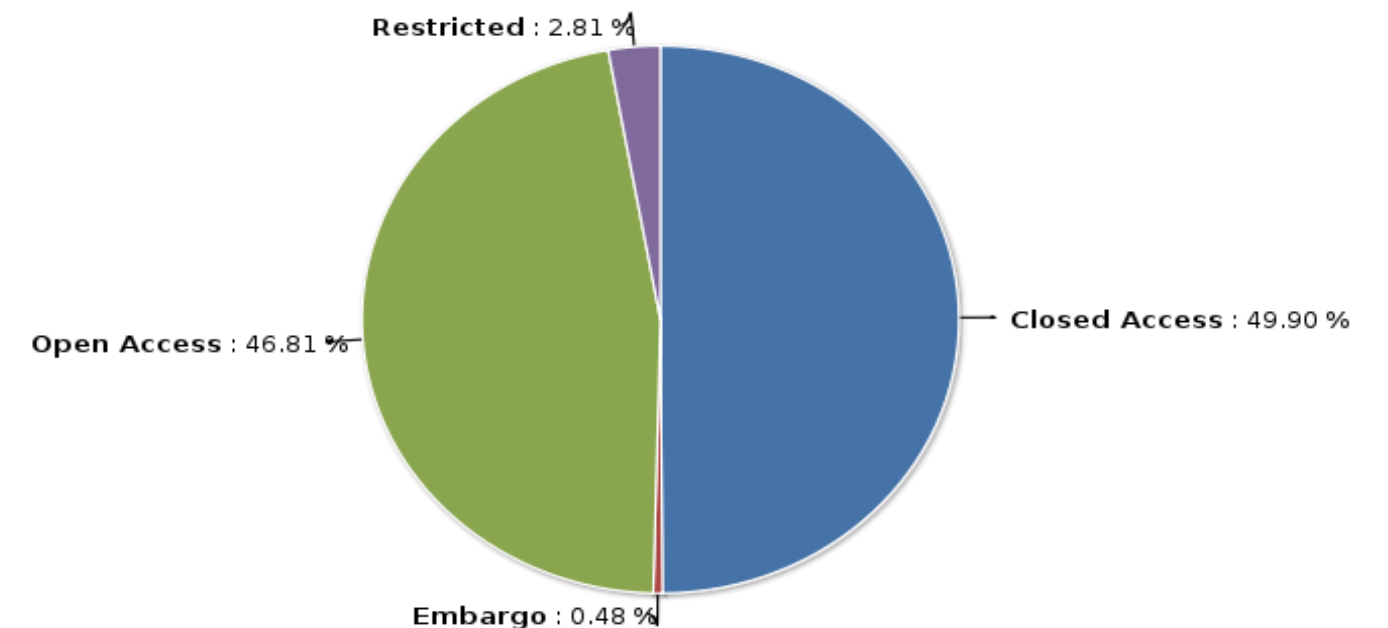
FP7 publications breakdown by access mode

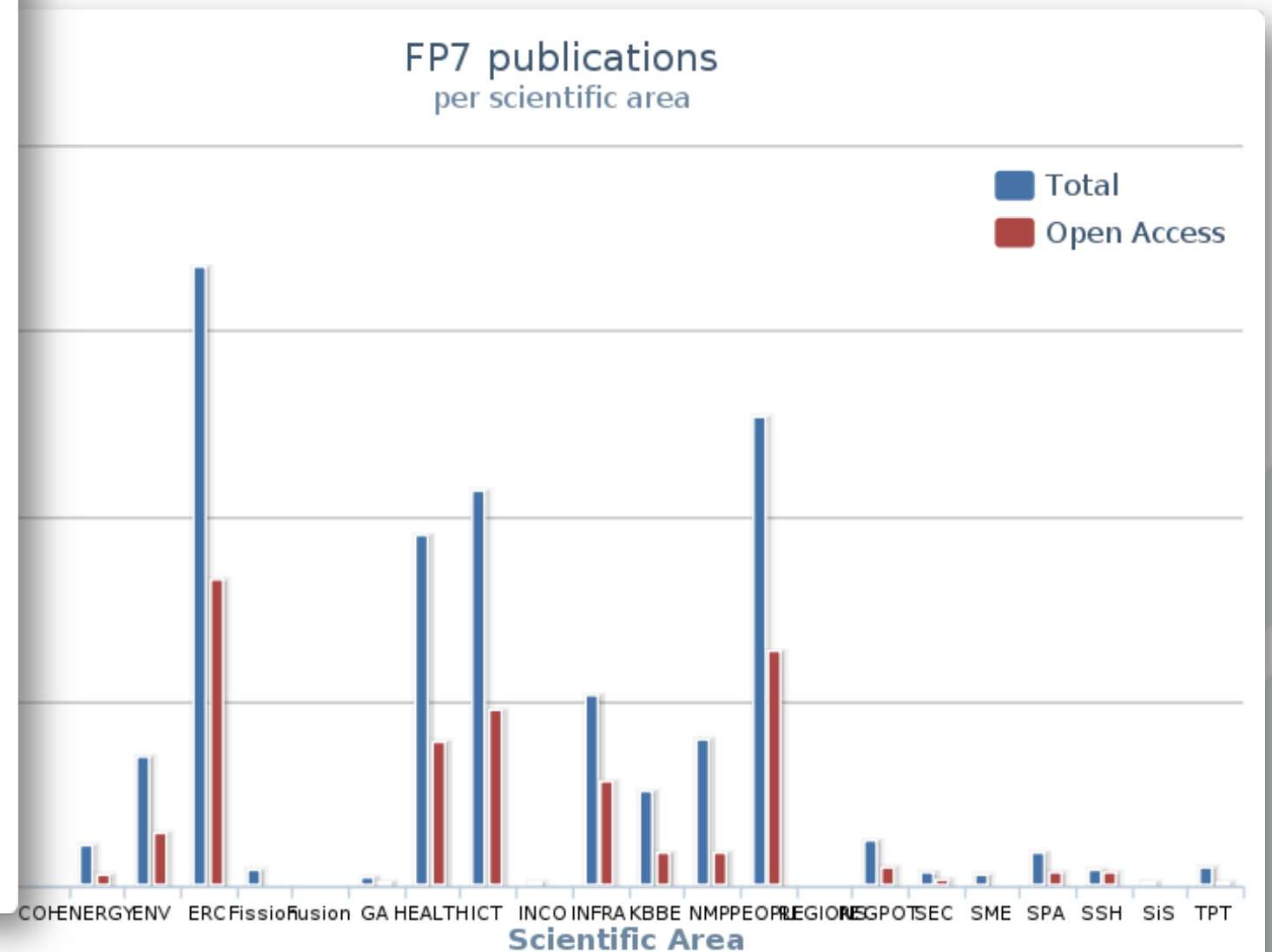
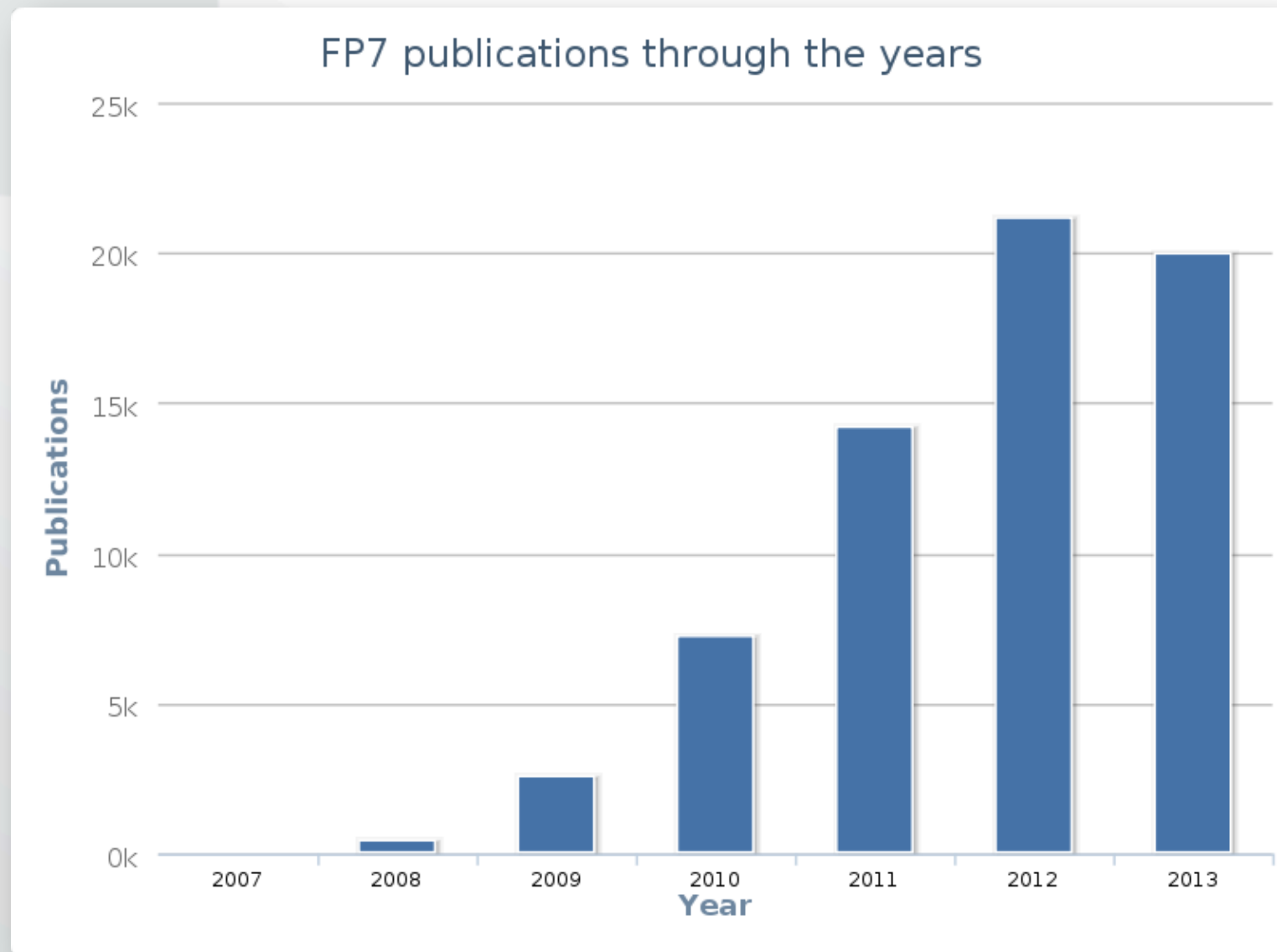

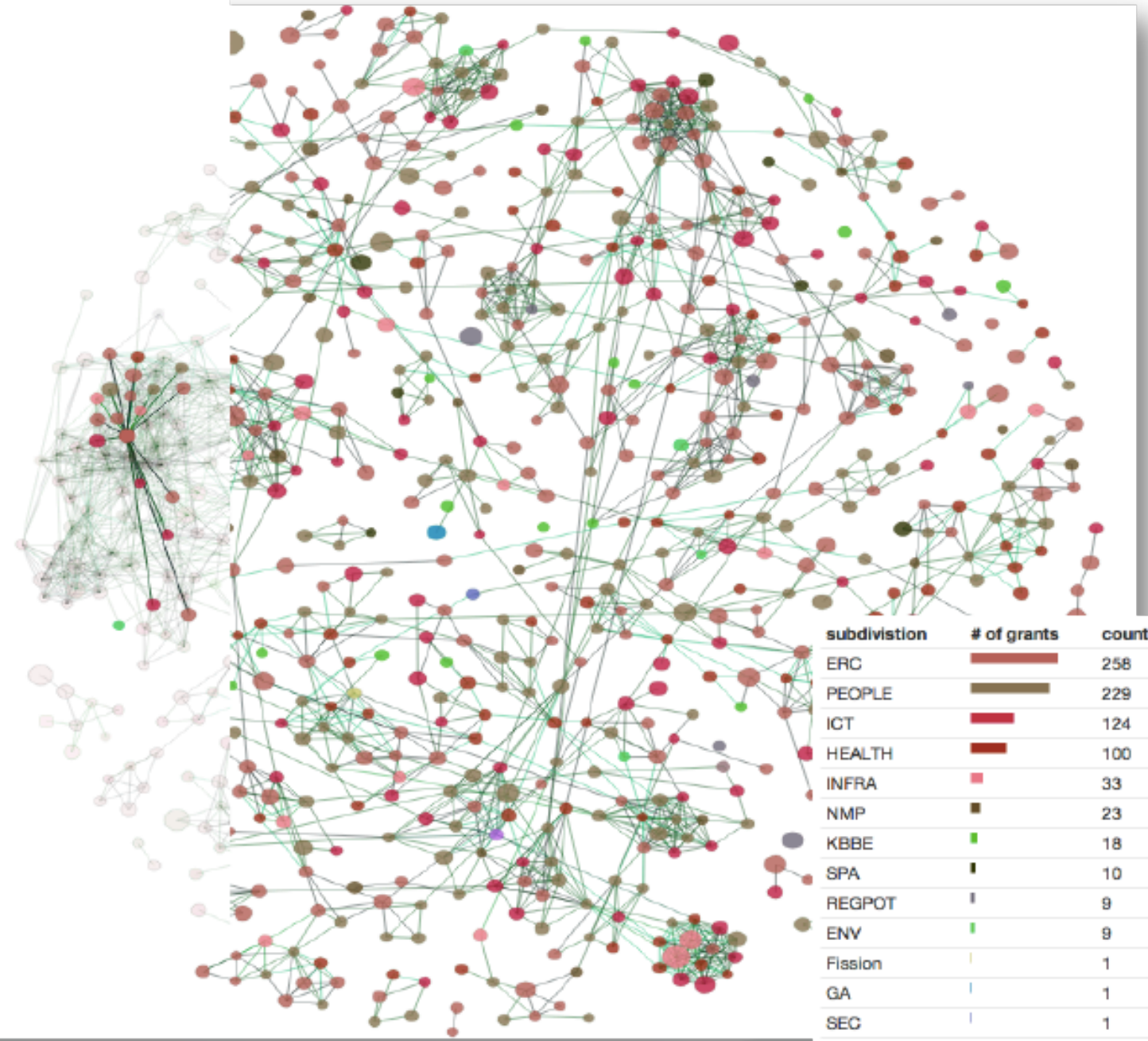
